A quirky wooden Antonio Pio Saracino chair adds a sense of levity to the room. "I wanted a chair that was sculptural and delivered a strong presence," the designer says. A gleaming bronze John Lyle coffee table, a tufted-linen sofa, and a floor lamp from Maison Gerard ("it's like a giant 1920s umbrella") add to the eccentric mix.
